

## Content Coverage for Sports and Clubs Section

### What content is covered for sports teams and clubs?

Content check list	
Sports	Clubs
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• a group shot of the team</li><li>• sports teams are to be photographed in their sports attire in their sporting venue, for example, the basketball team is to be photographed in the gymnasium, in their jerseys with one basketball</li><li>• a complete list of all team players/roster or club members with correct spelling</li><li>• shots of their practices</li><li>• shots of their team in play</li><li>• a blurb from a coach, captain or team player</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• the group shot</li><li>• an inclusive list of club members with correct spelling</li><li>• shots of events that they participate in</li><li>• a variety of club member action shots, from junior to senior</li><li>• a small write up about the club by the teacher representative or club members</li></ul>

### Who is responsible for the content of the sports and clubs section?

Each and every class member is responsible for gathering the content of the sports and clubs section.

### How does this happen?

Each person will be assigned a **minimum** of one sport or club. That way, the work is divided evenly among the class. Ultimately you are responsible to the class to have all the content for that sport or club. More importantly, you are responsible to the members of that sport or club who are expecting to see themselves in the yearbook.

### What happens if a sport or club does not get covered?

- The team or club will not go into the yearbook.
- You will not get any marks for that part of your portfolio.
- Mildly put, the members of the team of club will be disappointed. In fact, some will be angry.

### Do you get to choose your sport or club that you will be covering?

- Ultimately it depends on the needs of the book.
- You will likely be more motivated to cover a sport or club that you have chosen, so there will be some choice, however, you may be assigned a club or sport that is not necessarily your first choice.
- Again, it depends on the needs of the book.

### Can you have more than one person work on one sport or club?

Yes and No! At the end of the day one person will be **primarily** responsible for that sport or club. You may have others who help, but it is the first person who is ultimately responsible.

### **Who is responsible for the layout out the sports and clubs section?**

This is where most people are confused. The person who is responsible for the sports or clubs section WILL NOT necessarily do the page layout. That is the job of a small group of students who have been assigned that responsibility. There may be students who are doing the sports and clubs layout, who have also done the coverage.

### **Why do I have to take shots of the team while in practice?**

2 reasons:

- In any give game, all team members will not get an equal amount of play time. Aside from the team photo, we want to make sure that all team members are included in the yearbook.
- It gives you a chance to practice the tricky skill of taking sports photos.

### **How you coordinate the group shot?**

- Talk to the teacher representative ahead of time. Have the teacher representative tell the sports team or club members which day the team shot will be taken. Explain to him or her that the first opportunity to take the group shot is the best opportunity.
- If there are missing players or club members, take the group photo anyway, and reschedule for another day. That way, you have at least one photo.
- Always do the team shot before a game. People won't smile if they just lost a game, nor will they look their best after a game. They will be sweaty and flush.

### **I've never taken a team photo before. What do I do?**

There no magic in taking team photos. More people you have on a team, the more difficult it is to be creative.

- Use a tripod.
- Don't overlap faces.
- Create levels
- Girls can be "huggy" for a photo; boys..... good luck!
- Brunato will help, however, you just have to get him when the team is ready.

### **Where do you put all this content?**

For sports teams, put the content in a folder on your user drive using this method:

"yearbook"\_ "sports"\_sport\_gender\_division

For example: yearbook\_sports\_football\_boys\_senior.

### **I don't have experience taking action shots. What do I do?**

- Use the sports lens and practice during class if possible. The Healthy Active Living classes are always doing something that can be photographed. Talk to the HAL teacher and delete the photos thereafter.
- Go pictures during practices. Practice at the practices!
- Take lots of shots. Digital photos are free.

### **When do you collect the content of the sport or team?**

Immediately! Every practice or home game missed is a missed opportunity to have the team photo or action shots.

However, there is no expectation for you to travel to away games to get pictures.
